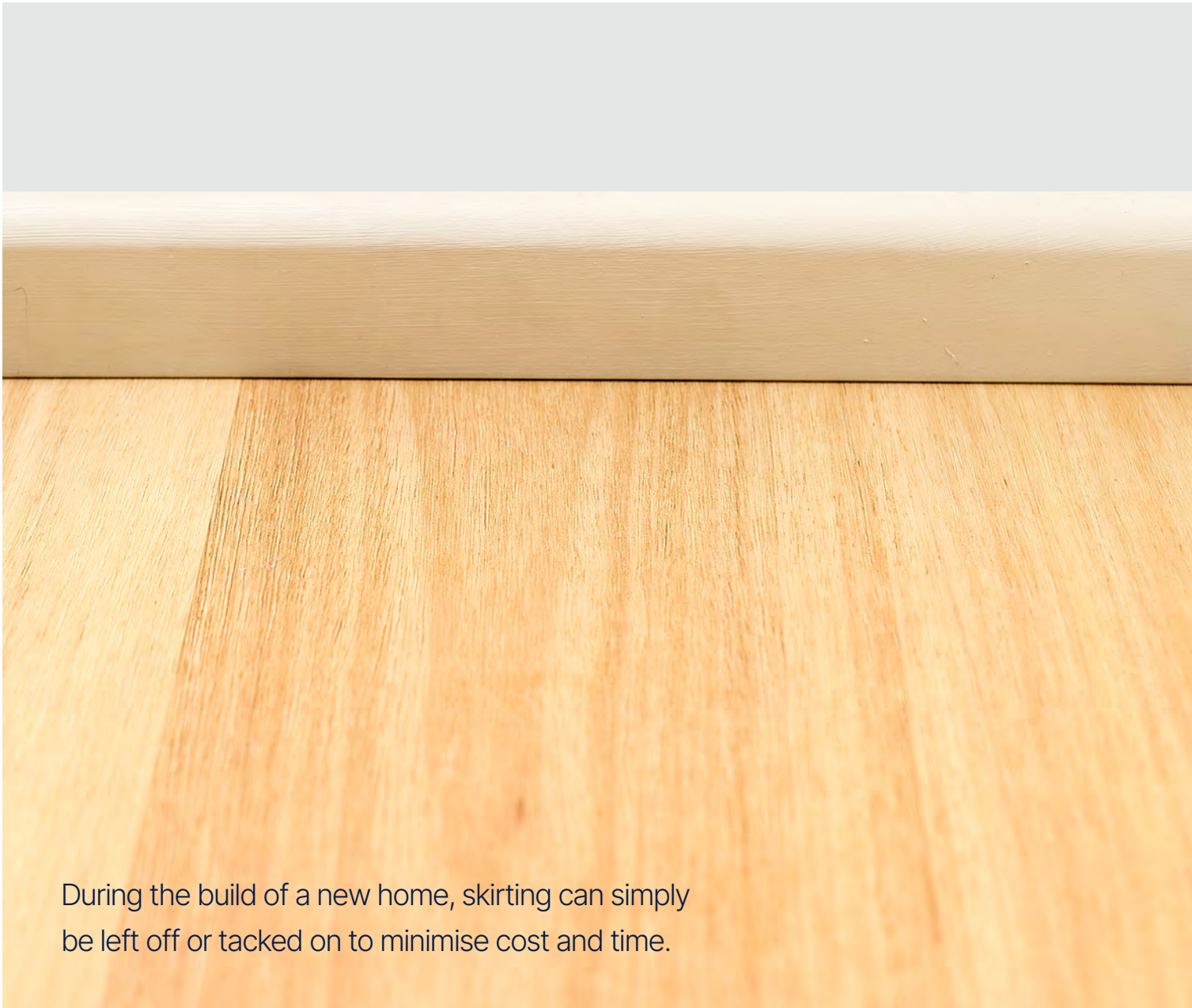


Finish around walls

Skirting

To avoid additional cost, skirting should always be installed after the flooring has been laid with the proper expansion gaps.

If skirting is fitted before the floor has been installed, it must be removed and refitted. This can cost additional labour time in repainting and potentially new skirting altogether if it is damaged in the process.



Scotia

Scotia is a decorative timber moulding that matches colour of flooring. It can be attached to existing skirting to cover expansion and contraction gaps without needing to remove and replace the existing skirting.



Silicone

Products that have less expansion properties can be finished with a neat silicone edge. Avoids having to use scotia or additional trims.

Not suitable for all products.
Will cause an unsuited product to fail.
