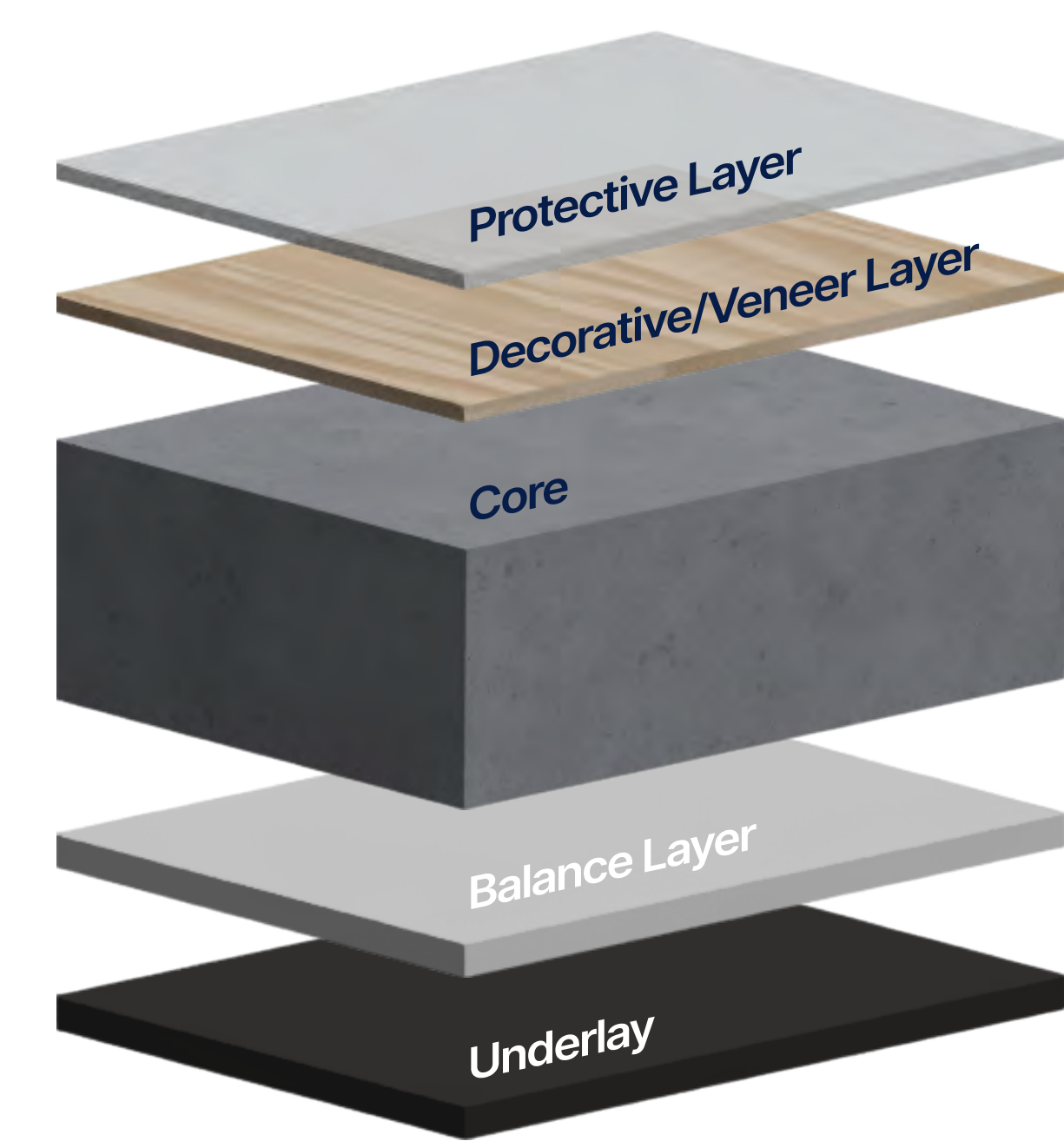


Board Construction

All of our products are built from varying combinations of the layers shown below. Not every product uses all of these layers. You can see how each product differs on the right.



Thickness

In Laminate and Resilient Solutions, thickness usually indicates click strength and stability. This is generally similar with timber veneers, and thicker timber also offers better sanding potential to give the product more longevity. However, thinner timber products are less affected by water.

Laminate Solutions



Protective Layer

These products are protected by a Melamine top coat that makes them incredibly durable. The labour-intensive coating and curing process means products are highly scratch resistant.

Decorative Layer

Our Laminate Solutions feature a high-quality Paper Print on the decorative layer. This is important for laminates as the wear layer resin combines with the print to become the top layer.

Core Layer

Each of these products feature a variation on a HDF core, to support the Melamine coat with rigidity and stability. Classic has a strict HDF core, Hydro features a Carbon Wax core, and Shield features a Waxed Wood Composite.



Grain matched embossing is rarely seen on laminate products due to the already labour-intensive coating and curing process. However, both our Hydro and Shield ranges include this feature.

That's **Clever**.
